PARENT AGREEMENT FORM – 2018-2019

(Please read carefully before signing)

1. We agree to pay the registration fee as indicated on the Tuition & Fees Schedule. We agree to pay all tuition and fees in a timely manner as set forth in the CBCS Tuition & Fees Schedule. We understand that monthly tuition payments are due on the first day of each month and that our child(ren) may not be allowed to attend school past the tenth of the month if the payment for the month has not been paid. We further understand that if we fail to make a timely payment, our child(ren) may be withdrawn from school and we may be subject to late-payment fees and other costs, including any necessary costs of collection in accordance with ministry policy.
 - a. We agree to pay the registration and comprehensive fees on or before the first day of August and understand that our child(ren) will not be allowed to start school until they are paid.
 - b. We prefer to pay as checked:
 - _____ Ten equal payments on the 1st of each month August through May (if the August payment is not made, tuition will be automatically divided into 9 equal payments September through May)
 - _____ Nine equal payments on the 1st of each month September through May
 - _____ Two equal payments on the 1st of August and January (1.5% discount) (Grades 2-8)
 - _____ Full payment on the 1st of August (3% discount) (Grades 2-8)
 - c. We choose to enroll our K4 or K5 student for a _____ half day _____ full day.
2. We understand that the account must be paid in full in order for our child to participate in kindergarten graduation and eighth grade graduation. We also understand that report cards and/or school academic records will not be released by CBCS until the account is paid in full.
3. We have read the school's discipline policy and the Student Handbook and grant permission to the school authorities to discipline our child according to this policy. We agree that we and our child(ren) must abide by all of the policies, rules and regulations of the school, including those listed in the Student Handbook, and we agree to support CBCS with our conduct and our prayers. We further agree that we will cooperate and provide Biblical discipline of our child(ren) in the home.
4. We understand that CBCS reserves the right to expel any child who fails to comply with the established regulations and discipline or whose financial obligation remains unpaid after the due date. We further understand and agree that attending CBCS is a privilege. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, this Agreement does not bind either party to any specific period of enrollment. Either party may terminate this Agreement without cause upon seven (7) days written notice. We understand that no rights or presumptions of continued enrollment are conferred or implied by this Agreement or by a number of consecutive Agreements. We further agree that no right to notice of renewal or nonrenewal of the Agreement is conferred or implied.
5. We understand that CBCS is an integral and inseparable part of the ministry of Calvary Baptist Church. We understand that the doctrines taught and upheld by CBCS shall in every respect be consistent with the doctrines held by Calvary Baptist Church.
 - a. We agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of CBCS by providing a place at home for our children to study and by giving our children encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments.
 - b. We understand and agree that parental support is an essential part of the educational process and pledge to support the faculty and administration and uphold the Biblical standards articulated in the ministry's Statement of Faith.
 - c. We understand that the standards of CBCS do not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to God and/or His Word or disrespect to the personnel of the school.
 - d. We understand and agree that the education of our child(ren) will be guided by the instructors and other school officials. We agree that our purpose in obtaining a Christian education for our child(ren) will be achieved by following the curriculum set by the instructors. To that end, we agree that we will require our child(ren) to perform all duties and responsibilities entrusted to him/her by the instructors and school officials to the best of his/her ability to their satisfaction. We will support the decisions of the instructors and school officials and

will never attempt to undermine their authority. We understand and agree that during our child's enrollment the courses offered and the instructors teaching them may change from time to time in the discretion of the school leadership.

6. We hereby agree to accept all regulations of the school on our child(ren)'s behalf. We also agree that if we are dissatisfied with any part of the school program, or if our child(ren) shall become involved in any difficulty with other child(ren) in the school, that we will not discuss these matters with any other parents or parties but come directly to the teacher, principal, and or administrator and voice our concerns to them.
7. We consent to our child(ren) being photographed during the school year. We further agree that CBCS shall have the right, but not the obligation to use our child(ren)'s photograph, likeness (including caricature), biographical information, and any reproduction of simulation thereof, for any yearbook, publicity, promotional, training aids, or website at any time and for any other purpose or materials the ministry deems necessary.
8. As we are Christians and Calvary Baptist Church together with its educational ministry, Calvary Baptist Christian School, is a Christian ministry organization, both parties agree that they would never make demands, threaten to sue, or actually litigate any matter whatsoever relating to or resulting from this Agreement. We understand that making demands, threatening to sue or actually litigating a matter against the ministry clearly violates Biblical teaching and practice and shall constitute sufficient grounds for immediate withdrawal of all our children from enrollment at CBCS. I understand that retaining or instructing an attorney to contact the ministry with regard to a potential claim or dispute will be considered a threat to sue. Accordingly, the parties agree to resolve all potential claims, disputes or causes of action through binding arbitration using the procedures outlined adopted by Calvary Baptist Church & Christian School.
 - a. We agree to follow the Biblical principles articulated in Matthew 18:15-17 and Galatians 6:1 and always give a good report. All differences are to be resolved by utilizing Biblical principles—always presenting a united front.
 - b. The parties agree that the methods outlined in this section (§9) shall be the sole remedies for any and all controversies or claims arising out of the enrollment relationship or this Agreement and expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit against one another in any civil court for such disputes, except to enforce a legally binding arbitration decision.
 - c. We acknowledge that we have read and understand the Procedures for Arbitration adopted by Calvary Baptist Church & Christian School and agree to abide by the procedures outlined therein.
 - d. We agree to do everything in our power to avoid involving Calvary Baptist Church & Christian School in any legal proceedings which may take place or legal requests for documents or testimony of school officials concerning the custody and/or education and upbringing of our child(ren). We understand that if, in spite of my and my attorney's best efforts, any school official is legally compelled to provide testimony or documentation beyond a copy of my child's standard academic records (Ex. divorce/custody/visitation disputes), that the ministry may have to disenroll my child from CBCS and that my account may be charged for any and all unrecovered expenses incurred in complying with such legal process.
9. The parties agree that there are no other agreements or understandings between them relating to the subject matter of this Agreement. This Agreement supersedes all prior agreements, oral or written, between the parties and is intended as a complete and exclusive statement of the agreement of the parties. Neither this Agreement nor its execution have been induced by any reliance, representations, stipulations, warranties, agreements or understandings of any kind other than those expressed herein. If any provision of this agreement is found to be void or voidable, it shall not affect the validity of any other provision. Both parties shall remain bound by all other provisions.
10. We understand that this Agreement shall not take effect until and unless fully executed by all parties.
